MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE LAKE VALLEY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT OF EL DORADO COUNTY January 9, 2025

The Board of Directors of the Lake Valley Fire Protection District of El Dorado County met in regular session on January 9, 2025 at Fire Station 7 in Meyers.

ROLL CALL

Director Rice called the meeting to order at 4:00pm. There were present the following directors: Rice, Kaelin, Cain, and Hogan. Fire Chief Stephen and Lake Valley personnel were present. Director Rice left the meeting at 4:30pm and the proceedings were taken over by Director Cain.

AGENDA

OLD BUSINESS

A. JPA Update

Director Rice shared that the new building is expected to be completed in early February.

NEW BUSINESS

A. Oath of Office for John Rice and Tim Cain

Director Rice administered the oath to Director Cain, then Director Cain administered the oath to Director Rice.

B. PERS UAL Presentation by Dmitry Semenov

Dmitry stated that the District refinanced the unfunded accrued liability (UAL) in 2021 in order to save approximately \$4.25 million. At current the District is about 91.2% funded while most Districts are about 70% funded. CalPERS itself is currently about 70% funded. Director Hogan stated that ideally the District wants to be about 92-94% funded at any time. Dmitry presented on CalPERS' investment earnings over the past few years and how that affects the District, as well as other insight on the District's UAL status.

B. Lake Valley Fire Protection District Chief's Report

Chief Stephen stated that the District is about half-way through the budget year and everything is tracking well. He expects to do a budget amendment at the February meeting. He stated that the District's Development fees are due to be updated, and are updated every eight years. The district currently charges \$0.98 per square foot, while some Districts charge up to \$3.00. An impact study will be done to see how the rates should be increased. He also added that the Strategic Plan is ready to move forward on the next steps with the committee.
